Reminder - 95db Enforcement

All Clubs and hirers of Pukekohe Park and Hampton Downs have received notification about the 95db Enforcement. NO vehicle or machine may exceed the noise level of 95 dBA at any time either on the circuit or within the grounds. This is also a MSNZ requirement and it is being strictly enforced with contracted noise control officers testing from both the inside and the outside of the track and reporting back to race control. Should any vehicle exceed this, you will be black flagged. You will not be able to finish racing for the day unless you have managed to bring your race car within the decibel reading. They are onsite all day at every track hirage. We do not want Puke or Hampton to become another Western Springs drama, so please ensure your race cars fit the requirements.
